Summer School in Yogyakarta, Indonesia

The third edition of the international summer school *Southeast Asia in Motion* will take place from **4 – 22 of July 2022**, and be hosted by Gadjah Mada University in Yogyakarta, Indonesia.

This summer school is a unique collaboration between universities in Switzerland, Indonesia, Vietnam, Cambodia, Myanmar, and Thailand. Groups will be formed with students from these different universities and together they will conduct ethnographic research focusing on the topic “After Covid? Work and Daily Life in Indonesia”. With this theme, we aim to explore the multitude of ways in which the pandemic has transformed and continues to affect the daily lives and work of people living in Yogyakarta. Inspired by the book *It’s a Living: Work and Life in Vietnam Today*, edited by Gerard Sasges, we hope to explore ways of portraying people, their biographic history, and their current daily life in a multimodal way, using ethnographic methods as well as film and photography.

The three-week program will start with several days of lectures on the campus of Gadjah Mada University, in which we will explore the Indonesian context from different perspectives as well as deepen our knowledge about ethnographic research methods. After that, students will have about 14 days to conduct their fieldwork in international, interdisciplinary, and multilingual groups. In the last week, we will be joined by lecturers from the participating universities from across Southeast Asia for a workshop, in which the students will also present the findings of their research.
